Camper Cabins



Eight Camper Cabins are located five miles up West Brush Creek from the Visitor Center. The camper cabins rent for \$60/night and will sleep up to six people.

Cabins 2, 3, 4 & 5 face the lake for easy fishing access. Cabins 2 & 3 are one room cabins; Cabins 4 & 5 are divided into sleeping and living areas. Cabins 6, 7, 8, & 9 are tucked into the pines for privacy. Cabins 6 & 8 are one room cabins; Cabins 7 & 9 are divided into sleeping and living areas. Pets are allowed in Cabins 2 & 8 only for a \$10/night fee.

- One queen bed
- 2 twin bunks
- Fold out cot
- Table & chairs
- Propane heating stove
- Solar lighting (no electricity)



- Storage cupboard & shelves
- ADA approved picnic table (outside)
- Fire ring with cooking grill (outside)

Yurts

Yurts rent for \$60 per night and will sleep up to six people. Three yurts (round tent-like structures with wood flooring) are located 4½ miles up East Brush Creek from the Visitor Center and nine miles from the lake. These provide a perfect base camp for fishing, hiking and other access to the White River National Forest. Pets are welcome in Yurt #3 for a \$10/night fee.
