Pavilion Features

This universally accessible, sheltered pavilion offers:

- ◆ 100 person capacity
- ◆ two charcoal grills
- ◆ 15 universally accessible picnic tables
- ◆ electrical outlets and lights
- ◆ counter tops
- ◆ running water
- ◆ adjacent restrooms
- ◆ horseshoe pits
- ◆ access to trails
- ◆ volleyball court

The reservation fee is \$90.00 per day. All vehicles must display a valid Colorado State Parks pass. Passes can be purchased at the park entrance station or the Nature Center.

And there's more!

Enjoy a diversity of trailheads, lake views, and the Barr Lake Nature Center just yards away. Venture through the wildlife refuge on the Neidrach and Perimeter trails in the south half of the park, or delve into grasslands on the Prairie Welcome Trail to the north. Take a stroll, walk the dog, pedal a bike, ride your horse, paddle the canoe, cast your fishing rod, or spy birds and wildlife. You can also experience solitude, cherish the quiet, and behold brilliant sunsets at Barr Lake State Park.

Just to let you know

1. The park is open daily from 5 am to 10 pm. Meadowlark Picnic Pavilion rentals are from 8 am to 9 pm.
2. Pets must be kept under control and on no more than a six foot hand-held leash.
3. Drive and park in designated areas only.
4. Build fires only in provided grills.
5. Only 3.2% alcohol is allowed on state property. No kegs are permitted.
6. Collecting of living or dead plants or animals is prohibited.
7. **In the wildlife refuge:**
Visitors must remain on designated trails. Boating, fishing, hunting, pets, and fires are prohibited.
