

# Bonny Lake State Park



## OHV REGULATIONS

1. The only OHV's allowed in this area are commonly known as 3 Wheeler's, 4 Wheeler's, and off road Motorcycles. No passenger vehicles, trucks, SUV's Jeeps, Dune Buggies, Campers or vehicles over 50 inches in width.
2. Operation only allowed on dry lake bed (Below high water mark that is lined by old trees) and inside North Cove campground. Do not go past signs prohibiting operation located near the southwest corner and near the old boathouse. See map for operating area. Caution, tall vegetation may hide unknown riding hazards.
3. Stay on roads while in campground. Enter area only from North Cove boat ramp in campground. Speed limit in campground is 5 m.p.h
4. Stay away from water and any muddy area. Mud is very soft and any vehicle can get stuck. Operator/ Owner responsible for any damage to machine and/or towing charges due to stuck machines.
5. Machines must be currently registered and obey all state OHV statutes and regulations. Noise from machines must not exceed 96 decibels. Riders should wear helmets and eye protection.
6. No child under 10 years old may operate an OHV. Any person 10 years or older may not operate an OHV unless they have a valid drivers license or they are accompanied by a person with a valid drivers license and are under immediate supervision.
7. Area is open from sunrise to sunset, unless accessing the lake for night fishing. Area closed from November 1 to January 31 for waterfowl refuge. Area may close to inclement weather.
8. Failure to follow these rules may result in fine and/or eviction from the area.
