

Group Campsites

Cherry Creek State Park offers three group campsites, at reasonable rates, that are ideal for families, clubs and organized groups. The convenient location makes it possible to combine sites for larger groups.

All three sites, **Chief Ouray**, **Arapahoe** and **Cherokee**, have electric and water and will accommodate campers, trailers, and RV's as well as tents. Each site has picnic tables, grills and fire pits. The sites also have their own unique characteristics outlined below.



Chief Ouray site will allow plenty of space for 72 people and room to set up 24 tents, RVs or campers, with a maximum of 12 RVs or campers. An additional 12 vehicles may park at the site. This site also has a shelter with two bathrooms and a kitchen area.

Arapahoe site accommodates up to 36 people and room to set up 12 tents, RVs or campers, with a maximum of 6 RVs or campers. There is parking for 6 additional vehicles. This site also has a shelter with a unisex bathroom and a kitchen area.

Cherokee site accommodates up to 36 people with and room to set up 12 tents, RVs or campers, with a maximum of 6 RVs or campers. There is parking for 6 additional vehicles.

Reservations may be made up to 6 months in advance. Call the Campground Registration Office at 303-693-3957

Rules and Regulations

- Check-in and check-out time is NOON daily. Group campsites must be vacated by NOON.
- Observe quiet hours from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. Generators and music must be turned off during these hours.
- Only 3.2% (or less) alcohol is allowed.
- All vehicles must remain entirely on designated parking area.
- No motorized scooters or kids' cars are allowed in the Campground or on any Park roadway or trail.
- Nothing may be hung on, from, or attached in any way to trees, shrubs, or any park building or sign.
- All pets must be on a maximum six-foot leash at all times.
- Pet owners must clean up after their pets and deposit waste in proper containers.
- Littering, including cigarette butts, is unlawful and harmful to wildlife and the environment.
- Open flame fires are permitted only in the designated fire pits. All fires must be attended at all times. Gas and propane grills are allowed.
- Purchase firewood at the campground office to prevent the spread of harmful insects. Wood gathering is prohibited.
- The washing of motor vehicles is not allowed.

Amphitheater Rental

The Amphitheater may be rented in 4 hour increments. A non-refundable reservation fee of \$10.00 will be added to each reservation.

Things to do while at the "Creek"

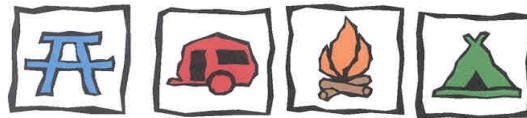
- Go for a swim at the beach
